TECHNICAL AND HEALTH STANDARDS FOR MEDICAL BILLING & CODING SPECIALIST

Every student in the Medical Billing and Coding Specialist program must possess the physical, mental, and emotional capabilities required to successfully complete the program and gain employment in the field. - Possess the proper motor skills to use standard office equipment.
- Be competent using MS Office, particularly Word and Excel.
- Possess good interpersonal, analytical and critical thinking skills.

Health Standards

The prospective Medical Billing & Coding student must:

- Consistently demonstrate emotional, mental, and physical health.
- Possess adequate hearing in order to communicate with patients, family members, and medical staff.
- Be able to handle stressful situations related to billing and insurance.
